
Saco Bay Artists

April 14 Meeting Notes


- SBA has reprinted our informational rack cards that can be handed out to individuals that might be
 interested in our group. Please contact the Show Coordinator <u>Mary Greto- Brunner</u> or <u>Heather Fountain</u>
 pick up a supply to bring to shows or other meetings you are participating in.
- The proposed 2025 budget was reviewed.
 - The increase in income in recent years is coming from full shows and an increase in members.
 - o A CD will be considered to earn some income on part of the cash balance.
 - The Gertrude Eastman Scholarship and the Elizabeth Horton Shore Award are separate funds.
 - A motion was made and passed to increase the scholarship award from \$500 to \$1000.
 - The full budget was approved by members.
- Cathy Turpin provided the treasurer's report.
- Heather led a conversation about establishing SBA's right to privacy policy with regard to what personal
 information members are willing to share with other members.
 - Options discussed included a members-only section on the SBA website, contacting the membership chair requesting contact information for particular members as needs arise, or printing and distributing a paper booklet once a year after the March membership deadline.

- Members voted for their preferred option via post it notes and a password protected membersonly section of the website was almost unanimously preferred.
- o Heather will follow up with our webmaster, Stephen, on what setting this up entails.
- At a future meeting, we will distribute a survey asking members what information they would like to share in the directory.
- If a members-only section is added to the website, other resources could be stored here as well for members to access:
 - The newsletter archive, so that contact people referenced in the newsletter isn't viewable to the public. We could consider keeping the most recent issue available publicly with this info removed.
 - There was discussion about also expanding the survey and member directory to include additional personal information that members may want to share with other members—art interests, professional skills & pursuits, hobbies, etc. This optional information could be added to planned member survey.
- Cathy T made the suggestion that SBA consider group activities or trips, sharing what classes are being taught at local Adult Education and Recreation Centers which also include potential art tours, etc.
- Ocean Park Bazaars
 - o These have been scheduled for Wed July 16 (rain date 17th) and Wed August 13 (rain date 14th).
 - Both run on the Curtis and library lawns from 9 am 1 pm with set up beginning at 7:30 am.
 - These are true bazaars (not a fine arts show).
 - o Forms will become available on the Ocean Park website or through Nancy Kenney closer to the event. Contact her ASAP to be added to the list as tables fill up quickly and are limited.
 - o Table registration is \$25 and the bazaars are usually very well attended.
