# August 2024 Meeting Notes

- Our meeting was held at Jordan Hall in Ocean Park and began with a friendly "meet & greet with someone you don't know" to talk about their art/medium.
- Vicki Lowe is now coordinating membership and reported we have 73 members, 14 of which are new this year.
- Cathy Turpin gave the treasurer's report.
- Kathy Angel Lee gave a show update:
  - The Aug show had 32 artists registered but 5 didn't attend because of weather/illness
  - Delayed opening due to rain but was able to begin at 11 am and extended to 5 pm
  - Artists included 17 fine art, 10 fine craft, and 4 photographers
  - Labor Day weekend show has 36 registered and there is interest in the 3 remaining slots so we will likely be full at 39; 2 are new participants
  - $\circ$  Mary Brunner was away for the Aug 3 show but will be back for the Aug 31 show
- The following are the award winners from the August 3 SBA show and comments from judge Susan Coburn Motta.
  - Best in Show Stephen Previte for consistent body of work
  - First Fine Art Kailleigh Archibald for beautiful botanicals

- First Fine Craft Danielle Gerber for professions use of materials
- Second Fine Craft Heather Fountain for interesting presentation
- Honorable Mention Richard Winslow for unique textures and colors
- Bill Edmunds Photography Award Joe Rokowski for booth
- Elizabeth Horton Shore Award oil/oil pastels Michael Reardon for unique subject matter

- The group discussed the Elizabeth Horton Shore Award, which had been changed from prior years because it was originally dedicated to oil pastel artists and there were too few of these artists participating in SBA shows (need at least 3 to present an award). SBA agreed earlier this year to expand the category but due to a misunderstanding, the award presented on Aug 3 went to an oil painter versus a pastelist. The group discussed this further and re-clarified that the intent of the annual award, which was established when the Oil Pastel Society of Maine disbanded, is to recognize pastel painting, and that oil painters are well represented with the fine art awards we offer at all shows. Going forward, the award will be limited to oil pastel or pastel artists and if there aren't at least 3 pastelists participating in a show, the award will not be given at that event.
- SBA will once again have an art show at the Libby Library beginning Sept 6. See more details in the events & happenings section below.
- SBA will also participate in the OOB/Ocean Park Holiday Art Walk, Saturday December 7. More details will be forthcoming later this fall.
