


#### **December Meeting Notes**

- It's time for SBA membership renewal, with 2025 dues set at \$45. Vicki Lowe is in MA until May so please bring dues checks to future SBA meetings and Cathy T will deposit them and notify Vicki of payment. Members will then receive a confirmation email from Vicki. - Cathy T provided the treasurer's report, with an ending balance of \$8934.
- Kathy Angel Lee gave an update on the successful Holiday Art Walk. There were more people than ever. While there weren't as many on the trolley, the two ladies who rode it to each stop had a fantastic time. Some were worried about too many people being on the trolley so we can advertise that a little better next year. The stop on Seaview Avenue will not be participating next year but we might have more spots for artists, so it's something for our members to think about. We also talked about getting the maps and advertising out sooner so that artists who have shows in November can have info at their booths.
- The group voted to approve SBA donations of \$250 each to the Libby Library, Dyer Library and Saco Rec. These will be sent with a letter from Heather.














### **Upcoming Opportunities**

## <u>Workshop: "Watercolor - Where do I Start"</u> Monday January 27, 2025 – 10:30-12:30 at Saco Parks & Rec, 75 Franklin Street in Saco

SBA member, Cathy Turpin, has offered to host this ultimate beginners workshop is for those of us who always were curious about watercolor as a medium but have no idea where to start. We'll learn what we will need for supplies, which surprisingly is very little. Basic techniques will be covered and we'll have plenty of time to experiment with those techniques. The goal is to have fun with this medium. Bring what supplies that you may have but there will be supplies available to work with.
