


Saco Bay Artists

June 2025 Newsletter



Saco Bay Artists meets from March through December on the second Monday of the month (except for holidays). All are welcome so feel free to bring anyone who is interested. The meetings are normally held from 10:30 am -12:30 pm at the Saco Parks & Rec Center at 75 Franklin Street in Saco.

There's parking on Temple Avenue, but also we are welcome to park pulling straight in on the grass behind the building which is Colby Avenue. It will start with an artist talk that we are sponsoring and opening for the community to join us as part of Arts in the Park week in Ocean Park. The featured artist is painter Amalia Tagaris, which will start promptly at 10:30.... with a short break and then will be followed by our meeting if there are any meeting items.

We also host open-studio "drop ins" at the Rec Center on most non-meeting Mondays from 10:00 am – 12:00 pm for those who would like to get together to paint, create & chat. June 9 Meeting Notes


1. Survey (Protection of Privacy) Heather has sent out an email asking members what information they may wish to share. This will appear solely on the Members Only page which will require a password to log into. Currently the Members Only page is blank but will eventually contain monthly newsletters as well.
2. Our July Meeting will be held at Porter Hall in Ocean Park since the Parks and Rec Building will be used for summer activities. See details above on location and parking.


3. Currently there are 71 paid members of Saco Bay Artists.
4. Treasurer's Report: Current balance is \$12,841.62. Cathy suggested that we look into putting part of that money into short term CD's. She is checking that out.
5. SBA show update: Mary reported that there are still some spots open for [all three shows this summer](#). She will be sending out map and placements of the tents/booths in the next couple of weeks. As of now:
 - July 4th: 34 Artists showing
 - Aug 2nd: 23 Artists showing
 - Aug 27th 27 Artists showing

During the Aug. 2nd Show, SBA will have a booth/tent. Members may sign up to show their work. It is dependent upon the number of people entered as to how many pieces may be displayed. Those participating will be asked to donate some time to man the booth.
6. SBA student scholarship. No applicants so far this year. This could just be a reflection of the times. Several ideas were suggested:
 - a. Perhaps extend this to other towns but that would need a vote to change the by-laws. It was also noted the Saco Bay Artists was originally established for the Saco Bay towns.
 - b. Expand the scholarship for older adults going back to school
 - c. Award a certain amount to a special art student
 - d. Offer money to a junior or community college to an art student starting out for expenses
 - e. Talk to guidance counselors at school, rather than just art teachers
7. Kathy reminded the group that it is the 30th Anniversary of Saco Bay Artists and that our event at the Saco Museum will be in September. It is a large facility. She has a list of current and former members that she will contact. Information will be emailed and the deadline for entries will be around August 1st.
8. [Saco Main Street Annual Arts Festival](#) is Saturday, June 21st. SBA will have a booth/tent. So far three people are interested. Those wishing to enter may choose to sell or display art of their choosing.
9. Art in the Park, Ocean Park, July 13-16. This year Arts in the Park week will encompass a series of arts events ranging from art camp, and art classes to art story time and the annual plan air event with six artists who were chosen by jury. The six artists arrive on Sunday, July 13 and will be creating around town through the 16th, culminating in a wet paint sale art show that evening from 5:00-7:30 PM in the Temple. As a note, artists are always welcome in Ocean Park to create around town anytime. Ocean Park is a very artist friendly community. More information can be found in the [event brochure](#).

Guest Presenter

Our guest presenter was Karen Gola, who gave an informative, entertaining, and lovely presentation on her work with glass. Having grown up in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, the historic center of glassmaking in North America, and coming from a Czech heritage, she was always enamored with exquisite glass pieces. She began her career working with stained glass and then fell in love with creating her own works of art capturing the organic essence of nature. Karen explained her process from design, use of templates, use of colored powdered glass, tools she worked with, firing in a kiln, to finished product. Her samples showed examples of pieces in various stages. She showed photos of her studio and how she displayed her work in galleries.

Both run on the Curtis and library lawns from 9 am – 1 pm with set up beginning at 7:30 am. These are true bazaars (not a fine arts show). Forms will become available on the Ocean Park website or through Nancy K closer to the event. Table registration is \$25 and the bazaars are usually very well attended.

- **Women in the Gardens at Coastal Maine Botanical Gardens in Boothbay Harbor:** SBA member Kailleigh Archibald will have her drawings of Maine wild blueberries from her Certificate in Botanical Arts featured in this exhibit from July 18 – October 19 in the newly refurbished café.



- **September: SBA 30th Anniversary Show at Saco Museum.** Set up will likely be Sept 2 or 3, with the date of the artists' reception TBD (likely a Thurs); take down will likely be Saturday Oct 11.
